From the Pulpit

Last Tuesday was the First Day of Winter, or the Winter Solstice. What was unique about it this year was that there was also a total lunar eclipse the same day. The last time a total lunar eclipse occurred on the winter solstice was 372 years ago in 1638. The winter solstice also happens to be the shortest day and the longest night in the northern hemisphere. This is significant because as John the Baptist once said of Jesus, "He must increase and I must decrease." Thus, we celebrate John the Baptist' birth on June 24, shortly after the summer solstice when the days begin to decrease and get shorter in the northern hemisphere. Whereas we celebrate Jesus' birth six months later when the light of day begins to increase and get longer. The point of this being that Jesus truly is our savior and he is the light of the world, he brings us light. He breaks our darkness of sin and death and brings us the light of truth, love and life. Because of his supreme importance to all of humanity, it makes sense then to date our calendars and our lives around him. If we are to carry the true spirit of Christmas within us, then we must learn how to let the light of Christ increase in us the whole year through.
