## The Call of the First Disciples

In our Gospel reading today (Mt 4:12-23) we hear about the call of the very first disciples right at the beginning of Jesus' ministry—first Simon Peter and Andrew then James and John.

In the few lines of today's Gospel, we see how Jesus picks up where John the Baptist left off. We are told that he has come to fulfill the scriptures, that he will bring light to the people; we are introduced to Jesus' inner group of disciples and see how they are called. And we are told about his ministry of healing among the crowds that flocked to hear him.

Those first apostles weren't made of very promising material and I don't suppose we are either. And even while they were with him they misunderstood his intentions and went so far as to desert and even deny him. And yet these were the ones he chose, they were the ones on whom he built his Church.
