From the **Paul**pit

On Ash Wednesday I received a couple of questions about the law of abstinence and fasting during Lent, so I thought I would clarify it in case anyone else was wondering. First of all, both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. We are also obliged to observe abstinence (but not fasting) on all Fridays during Lent. According to Canon Law, the law of fasting binds all Catholics from the completion of their 18th birthday to the day after their 59th birthday. The law of fasting allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening, or the full meal may be taken in the evening instead of midday. The quantity of food taken at the two lighter meals should not exceed the quantity at the full meal. The drinking of ordinary liquids does not break the fast.

The law of abstinence binds persons from the completion of their 14th year. So in other words, the law of abstinence applies to Catholics from the day after their 14th birthday and onward throughout life. Now that is something I never knew prior to becoming a priest, that children under 14 are not bound to follow the law of abstinence. All those years growing up, my mom made me eat fish on Fridays in Lent when I would have rather had a burger. But that's alright, it is good to get into the habit of abstinence while people are still young so that hopefully they will keep it up as they get older. The law of abstinence forbids the consumption of meat, but not of eggs, milk products or condiments made of animal fat. Soups flavored with meat, meat gravy and sauces are permitted.

Also, don't forget that on Fridays during Lent we have Stations of the Cross at St. Ignatius starting at 5:15 pm, Mass as always at 6:00pm, and then the Fish Fry over in the cafeteria/canteen from 5 until 8 pm. So please come and join us for this wonderful Lenten practice.
