## From the Paulpit

We have First Communions coming up soon, May 29th to be exact. I am reminded of this because not only is my niece receiving her First Holy Communion this weekend, but also because the recent Gospel stories this past week was about Jesus being the bread of life. When you look at the context of what Jesus is saying, it is really quite interesting. In John's account, Jesus had just fed five thousand people with the five loaves of bread and two fish. The next day, many people were looking for Jesus. And so Jesus says to them that they are looking for him just because he fed them. Jesus then says that we should look for the bread that doesn't perish. That we should look for the bread that will satisfy us forever, so that we will never hunger or thirst again. Then Jesus says that he is that bread. He is the bread of life. So what is he talking about? What Jesus was getting at was this: The people were looking for Jesus because he performed a miracle for them. He gave them a material need. They were looking for him because he helped satisfy a physical desire, and not because they were interested in Jesus or growing closer to God, or what this miracle meant on a deeper, more spiritual level. So Jesus tells them to look deeper. What are the things that you truly want and desire in life? Do we not want truth, life and real love? Jesus is the one that can give us these things, and we will never be truly satisfied until we have these things. Jesus is longing for a personal loving relationship with us, that is why he is offering us these priceless gifts. But is this what we hunger for? Is this where we set our hearts desire? It is not uncommon to chase after things that in the end doesn't really make our lives any happier. It therefore is good for us to remember the words of St. Augustine: "My heart will not rest until it rests in you O Lord." If we learn that lesson well, than we will chase after the bread that came down from heaven which satisfies our hunger forever. We will in other words search after the things that really matter, we will long for a better relationship with God, and grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ.
