## From the **Paul**pit

**Congratulations to those who received their First Communion this weekend. This is a very big step in the spiritual life and an extremely important part of the faith life as Catholic Christians. So much so that I feel I would be lost without it.**

**Why is that you ask? Well it is simple really. Ask yourself, what is the essential core of our faith? The very core of our faith is the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ because this was the event that has saved us from sin and death. This was the greatest act of love of all time that was given to humanity by God. This was the most important event in all of human history because this was the event that won eternal life for you and me.**

**It is this very event that is actually made present to us in the Mass. When we come to Mass, we participate in the very event that saves us from sin and death. The sacrifice of the Mass is the sacrifice on Calvary. That bread and wine really does become the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ which is offered up to us for our sins, for our salvation. Therefore, when we receive the Eucharist, we really do receive Jesus. That is why the Catechism of the Catholic Church says that the Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life because in it is Jesus himself. In it is the saving, sacrificial love of God.**

**This is why I say I feel I would be lost without the Mass and the Eucharist because if I didn't have these things, I would be going without the very core and centrality of our faith. I would be foregoing the opportunity to receive the infinite love that Jesus offers us in the Mass and the Eucharist, that very love that we are meant to take and then go forth and live out in our lives. That is what our faith is about, and all the teachings of our faith is summarized in the love that is exhibited in the Eucharist we receive.**

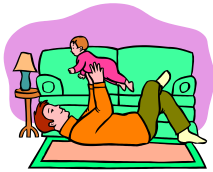
**General:** That priests, united to the Heart of Christ, may always be true witnesses of the caring and merciful love of God.
