June 26, 2011 — The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

From the Pulpit

The end of June is upon us and we have some important feast days this time of year. This Sunday of course is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, which I wrote about in last week's bulletin. This past Friday, the 24th, was the Solemnity of the Nativity of John the Baptist. We celebrate this special day six months before Christmas because the Gospel of Luke tells us that when the angel Gabriel came to announce to Mary that she would give birth to a son, Gabriel then tells Mary that her relative, Elizabeth, is in her sixth month of pregnancy. That child of Elizabeth was of course John the Baptist. It is also interesting to note that John the Baptist once said of Jesus that "He must increase, while I must decrease." We celebrate this solemnity of John the Baptist shortly after the summer solstice where the amount of daylight in the northern hemisphere begins to shorten, or decrease. Meanwhile, Christmas occurs shortly after the winter solstice, where the amount of daylight in the northern hemisphere begins to lengthen, or increase. As a result of this interesting factual tidbit, we are reminded that Jesus is the light of the world, he brings light into the darkness.

This coming Wednesday is the Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul. Both of them were martyred in Rome. St. Peter died around 64 A.D. under Emperor Nero, and was hung on the cross upside down. St. Peter requested that he be hung upside down, as he did not feel worthy to die in the same way that Jesus died. St. Paul was martyred about three years later. He was beheaded, which is why he is sometimes pictured with a sword. Pope Benedict XVI has said that St. Paul's success as an evangelizer was not credited to skills as a speaker or to a "refined strategy" of missionary argumentation. Instead, his achievements had more to do with his extraordinary personal involvement in announcing the Gospel and his total dedication to Christ, despite problems and persecutions. As a result, St. Paul's life holds a lesson for modern Christians. The action of the church is credible and effective only to the extent that Christians are willing to "pay personally for their faith in Christ, in every situation."

Finally, this coming Friday is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. On this Solemnity we celebrate Christ's deep, profound, limitless abyss of love as epitomized by the pierced heart of Jesus hanging on the cross. Jesus' pierced heart is a symbol of his redemptive love. Consequently, devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is quite popular and an important part of the prayer life of the church. We need to be reminded of God's love and how this is an essential characteristic of God. As a result, this Friday of course we will conclude the 6:00 pm Mass by doing the consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus devotion. All are welcome to attend.
